

FRANCESCA'S STORY

“WITH TEARS I ASKED
JESUS TO FORGIVE ME...”



Hi, my name is Francesca and I grew up with my sister, mother, and father who loved me and comfortably provided all my needs. I was brought up in the Catholic religion where I learned from a young age that there is a God, but even though I believed in God, I never really thought much about Him. I was not popular in my school years because I was always the larger girl and I didn't have many close friends. However, in year 10, I lost a lot of weight and started to become more popular. At this time I began making friends who had a different upbringing. They had different values and morals and they peer-pressured me into a lot of things. I always had a curious spirit and wanted to experience to the fullest what life had to offer. I developed a rebellious heart and bad attitude thinking that I knew everything and was in control of my life. I began smoking cigarettes and drinking under-age, and by the age of 17, I tried my first drug and loved the feeling that it gave me.

Gradually my first drug turned into a weekly party, as I got into the nightclub scene. Up to this point, I was just having fun, but I found that I wanted more. I met my husband who was also into the same scene, so we started going out together. We frequently went out clubbing but got to a point where our fun weekly habit became a weekly dependency, and within 6 months, it became a daily dependency. We lost our jobs, used all of our savings and I even stooped to stealing - we had lost control. It was funny to think that when we first started, we felt like kings, but now we were really unfulfilled sinners who were lost and had nothing, living a lie.

We wanted to get out of this cycle of sin and dependency, but our bodies and minds were too weak. This was the lowest point in my life. My husband and I isolated ourselves from our friends and loved ones. One night, we received a call from my husband's friends who asked if they could come over and see us, and for some reason my husband agreed. When they met with us they began sharing how Jesus died on the cross and saved them from their sins. They shared that if they died at that moment, they knew 100% they would be in heaven with their Saviour Jesus Christ. When they confronted us with the question of our eternal destination, I knew that if I died then, I was not going to heaven. They also shared about Jesus' death on the cross and that they experienced no greater love before, and if we accepted Jesus as our personal Saviour, we would be saved from our sin and would be in heaven with Him for eternity. When we heard this, we thought they were nuts, but we knew there was truth to it. Even though we didn't fully understand, something made sense to us. We thought we'd try it, try going to church to fix our lives up.

One Friday night, I could not make it to church so my husband went by himself; I received an overjoyed call from him that night saying that he heard a message about salvation through Jesus Christ. He heard that we are all sinners and we all need a Saviour and that there was no other way to God except through Jesus. He told me he prayed and accepted Jesus as his Saviour. It clicked to me that Jesus died for me, that He loved me greatly and that there was hope. I then prayed on the phone to God and accepted what Jesus did for me on that cross. I just told God that I was sorry, but I meant it with my whole heart. ; I told Him that I wanted to turn from the wrong I was doing and asked him to change me. After I knew I was a child of God, I had the best night's sleep ever. That assurance I had that if I died I would be in heaven with my Saviour gave me so much peace. I experienced real love and fulfilment through Jesus Christ that night and I have never looked back.

I'm not going to lie, it was hard to break my habits and I did have withdrawals, but God really gave me strength through those times. I allowed him to carry me through those storms in my life and clung onto his Word to strengthen me. Verses like Isaiah 41:10 "Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. God has truly blessed me abundantly; I

have a husband, children, my health. And even though life brings trials, I know Jesus is always with me and I have His promise of salvation.
